

Martinique / St Lucia / Martinique: 8 days

Day 1: Le Marin

Welcome in the Marina (South of Martinique) and boarding for the night.

Day 2: Le Marin / Anse d'Arlet: 15 miles

Getting used to the boat, provisioning and short navigation towards Petite Anse d'Arlet passing the Diamond Rock for lunch and swimming. First night at the anchorage at Grande Anse d'Arlet.

Day 3: Anse d'Arlet / Anse Mitan: 13 miles

After sailing along the coast and passing Cap Salomon, crossing the bay of Fort de France and anchoring at Fort Louis. Sight seeing tour of the town. Late afternoon navigation towards Anse Mitan, shops, restaurants, bars.

Day 4: Anse Mitan / St. Lucia: 37 miles

Early departure to Rodney Bay in St. Lucia. Crossing the channel may require visual navigation. Night in Marigot Bay, former hurricane shield now a bit crowded, so anchorage off the shore recommended.

Day 5: Marigot / Deux Pitons: 10 miles

Sailing along the natural coast of St. Lucia the day follows the rhythm of short navigation and excursions: Anse Cochon, la Soufrière, les Deux Pitons.

Day 6: Deux Pitons / Rodney Bay: 20 miles

Navigation under the wind of St. Lucia. Overnight at Rodney Bay behind Pigeon Island. Possibility to visit the botanic park.

Day 7: Rodney Bay / St. Anne: 23 miles

The crossing of the canal of St. Lucia is normally done with sea and wind on the beam. Anchoring outside St. Anne (traditional village and pretty beaches) or outside Club Med.

Day 8: Anne / Marin: 2 miles

After a last swim in a heavenly bay (turquoise water, white sandy beaches) back to the Marina of Marin (30 min.) where the Dream Yacht team will take care of you.
